Marketplace

Dates: **Friday, June 17 - Saturday, June 18, 2022.** (*Liberty Fest runs Thursday-Saturday, with the Marketplace only open Friday & Saturday.*) Please Note: Fireworks has been changed to Friday, with a rain date of Saturday.

Hours: **Friday: 4 p.m. - Dusk Saturday: 10 a.m. - Dusk**
With fireworks now on Friday night, expect highest volume of sales and exposure between 7-10 p.m. when the largest crowds occur.
There is no rain date for Marketplace booths and no refunds will be issued for inclement weather.

Location: **Heritage Park** - vendor location(s) within the park and festival grounds are to be determined by the Liberty Fest Committee.

Permits: If applicable, vendors will be required to provide proof of all necessary permits and insurance(s). Each exhibitor is responsible for securing any applicable local, county, state permits/licenses.

Fees: Application fee includes one 8-foot table, 2 chairs, and one 10'x10' tent.

All items sold and/or distributed must be approved in advance by the Liberty Fest Committee and will be *strictly enforced*.
